ABOUT THE ICCR AND ITS CONGRESS

The International Chair on Cardiometabolic Risk (ICCR) is an independent, academic, multidisciplinary organisation affiliated with Université Laval and located at the Centre de recherche de l'Institut universitaire de cardiologie et de pneumologie de Québec, in Québec City, Canada. It is composed of an executive council and a scientific council.

The members of both councils have been chosen based on their expertise, their remarkable scientific contributions, and their status as world leaders in their discipline. The makeup of both councils exemplifies the multidisciplinarity the Chair has sought to achieve, with all members active in complementary areas of expertise. The Chair provides a forum for them to share their knowledge and expertise regarding diverse pathologies—some of which are new—but all of which lead inevitably to cardiovascular disease.

A key aspect of the Chair is its international and multidisciplinary character, with the following disciplines represented: cardiology, diabetology, lipidology, endocrinology and metabolism, obesity, nutrition, physical activity, and basic research.

First called the *International Congress on Abdominal Obesity*, the ICCR International Congress has rapidly become the international platform to discuss novel approaches and share scientific and clinical data to benefit healthcare professionals, clinicians and scientists. The new name of the meeting, the *ICCR Congress on Chronic Societal Cardiometabolic Diseases*, reflects the Chair's evolving mission to fight a lifestyle epidemic of sedentary behaviours and low quality nutritional habits leading to chronic societal diseases.






Paricipants by Professionnal Expertise
